Devon Energy Corporation (Nevada) requests permission to place the subject well in a Temporarily Abandon status pending review by this company's geological and reservoir engineering departments. DEC requests a one-year term on this TA status. The West Pearl Fed. #1 is currently shut-in with a hole in the tubing. Current production rates do not make the well economically feasible to repair. Recent nearby offset activity provides hope that this wellbore will have utility in the future. However, based on economic status, the review of this well is still in the distant future.
