(2) The NE/4 SE/4 of said Section 33 is to be dedicated to said well to form a standard 40-acre oil spacing and proration unit for both the Blinebry formation and Undesignated East Vacuum-Drinkard Pool.

(3) Prior to commencing directional drilling operations however, the operator shall establish the location of the kick-off point by means of a directional survey acceptable to the Division.

<u>PROVIDED HOWEVER THAT</u> during or upon completion of said directional drilling operations, the applicant shall conduct an accurate wellbore survey from the kick-off point to total depth in order that the subsurface bottomhole location, as well as the wellbore's true depth and course, may be determined.

(4) The applicant shall notify the supervisor of the Hobbs district office of the Division of the date and time said wellbore surveys are to be conducted so that they may be witnessed. The applicant shall further provide a copy of said wellbore surveys to the Santa Fe and Hobbs offices of the Division upon completion.

(5) Form C-105 shall be filed in accordance with Division Rule No. 1105 and the operator shall indicate thereon true vertical depth in addition to measured depths for the Royal Well No. 1.

(6) Jurisdiction of this cause is retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
