Mr. Eric Engbrecht, Oil & Gas Inspector for the Commission, has made an inspection of the location for your plugged and abandoned Lee Carter et al No. 1 in Unit I of Section 21, T-17-S, R-38-E and has found that the cellar is caving in. Also the rat and mouse holes must be filled before approval can be made of your Report of Final Plugging. Please advise this office when the work has been done so that a final inspection can be made.

Further in checking our files we find that no forms have been filed for your Missouri Valley No. 3 in Unit K of Section 21, T-17-S, R-38-E and Sudie Manning No. 1 in Unit A of Section 18, T-17-S, R-38-E since Forms C-102 outlining your intention to plug the wells were approved on December 9, 1957.
