## DETAILS OF WORK

On the 5th day of December, 1952, the following work was done ~~by~~ **abandon**  
**for the Burner #3 well:**

**8-5/8" set at 867' with 30 sacks cement.****7" set at 2994' with 100 sacks cement.****5-1/2" set at 2994' and circulated.**

In attempting to salvage some casing, a shot went off prematurely at  
**30'.** Then ran **2" tubing to 1612'** where it stopped. Pulled tubing and run to **1092'**  
with packer.

Set packer and got reverse circulation; then pumped **325 sacks of cement,**  
pulled tubing and packer and ran **50 sacks** which filled **5-1/2" casing to surface.**

**Regulation marker was set and location cleaned up.****Above operations witnessed by a representative of U.S.G.S., Artesia, N.M.****Work done by R. A. Thomas. Well was making 22 bbls. oil & 650 bbls. water**  
**before being plugged.**

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
