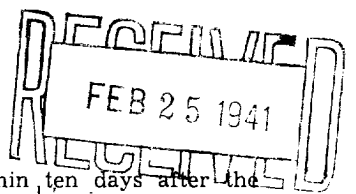

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

After cementing 920 feet of 8-5/8" 28# seamless casing with 50 sacks, let cement set two days and then drilled ~~down 100 feet below 8-5/8" casing~~ pulled 10-3/4" pipe which had water shut off. Then drilled cement plug and to 75 feet below 8-5/8" casing. Ran three-hour bailer test to determine if water completely shut off. The cement job was good and all water shut off.
