DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Impossible to get formation shut-off with 5 1/2" casing, therefore squeezed formation from 2627' to 2635' with 60 sacks of cement. Cement drilled out and well deepened to 2660', and tested for three days. Drilled to 2674', encountered soft lime pay to 2679'. Bailer test showed 3 barrels of oil per hour, with no water. Put on pump 4-23-43, 24 hour test showed 72 barrels.
