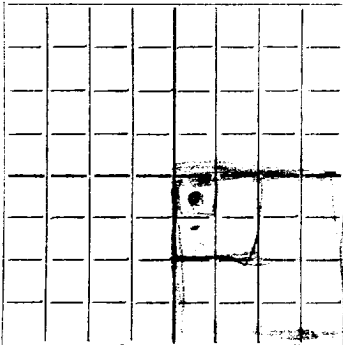

On 10/10/50, the New York Office received information from the New York City Police Department that Alger Hiss had been seen at the home of the late John Edgar Hoover, Director of the FBI, on 10/9/50.

It was further stated that the above information was obtained from a confidential source who had been in contact with the late Director Hoover.

The New York Office is currently conducting an investigation of the activities of Alger Hiss.
