DETAILS

State names of and expected depths to objective sands or producing horizon; show sizes, weights, and lengths of casing run or proposed; indicating mudding jobs, cementing points, water horizon, number of days operated, and total depth at end of month, and other important information. **Filled hole with heavy mud up to bottom of 6 5/8" casing and dumped 25 sacks of cement. Left 237' of 6 5/8" pipe in hole. Filled hole with heavy mud up to 2730 feet and set 10 sacks of cement. Filled hole with heavy mud to top of salt and dumped 25 sacks of cement. Left 60' of 12 1/2" pipe in hole. Filled hole with heavy mud to top and set regulation pipe marker in cement.**
