Dear Mr. Hunter:

The bookkeeping department of the State Land Office is very anxious to know whether or not the following wells have been properly plugged and abandoned:

(1) ~~W-1~~SE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 2, T. 18 S., R. 28 E., this particular tract of land was originally leased to Mr. Arba Green, Artesia, New Mexico, and was later assigned over to Alfred H. Ramage. In the files of the State Geologist's department here, we have form SG-101 and several other forms but nothing showing this well has been plugged or abandoned.

(2) SE $\frac{1}{4}$ NE $\frac{1}{4}$, Sec. 4, T. 18 S., R. 28 E., this land was originally leased to the Texmore Oil Company, it was then assigned to the Sunray Oil Company and later assigned to H. T. Hellman. I cannot find anything in the files here in connection with this particular well.

Any information you can give us concerning these wells will be greatly appreciated.
