This paragraph calls for the setting of the salt-protection string not less than 100 feet nor more than 600 feet below the base of the salt section; provided that such string shall not be set below the top of the highest known oil or gas zone.

Specifically, we give our permission to The Texas Company to set the salt protection string at a minimum depth of 50 feet below the base of the salt section for the above mentioned well only. We understand this procedure to be desirable in order for The Texas Company to obtain a satisfactory casing seat.
