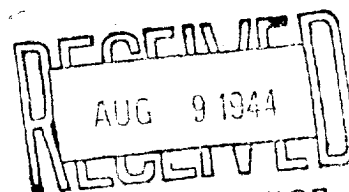

## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented from 3437 feet to 3420 feet. Filled with mud to 2845 feet. Cemented with 10 sacks cement. Filled with mud to 1160 feet. Cemented with 20 sacks. Pulled 7" O.D. Casing. Filled with mud to 560 feet. Cemented with 10 sacks. Pulled 8" Casing. Filled with mud to 500 Feet. Cemented with 10 sacks. Hole was bridged under each cement plug with wooden plug, sand and gravel to hold cement in place. Filled mud to surface and erected regulation marker.
