Gentlemen:

On December 1, 1959, I witnessed the running and cementing of the casing for the subject well which is located within the Potash Area described in Commission Order No. R-111A.

The cementing of the 5-1/2 inch casing was accomplished by a two stage procedure. The first stage, after approximate lag for cement to circulate, had a slight cut of cement stringers. Given 5-1/2 hours for the initial setting of cement used in the first stage, the second stage began to circulate before all the cement was mixed. (Approximate volume for excess taken from Caliper Survey calculations)

Good circulation was observed during both cementing stages. On the evaluation of all surface conditions, it is my opinion that a good cement job was obtained.
