## DETAILS OF WORK

This well has been plugged and abandoned as follows:

At total depth of 3803' set a plug of 15 sacks of cement; below the base of the salt (at 3280') set a plug of 15 sacks of cement on bridge with bailor; above the top of the salt (at 1575') set a plug of 15 sacks with bailor on bridge; in the surface set a plug of 10 sacks of cement. The hole was filled with mud between all plugs. A 6' joint of 4" pipe was placed in the cement at the top of the well and all the required information was placed thereon for a marker. Location is now ready for inspection.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
