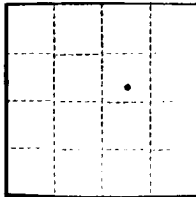

15 sacks of cement were spotted at surface, and a four-inch marker placed at the surface of the hole. As soon as the location has been cleaned off you will be notified.
