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DETAILS OF WORK

Well was drilled to a total depth of 3754'. Well was plugged as follows: 20 sax cement at total depth; 20 sax at the base of the salt which is at 3170'; 50 sax from 1570 - 1720; and 110 sax 0 - 100 feet. Balance of hole was filled with mud. Pits are leveled, steel marker is erected and location is ready for inspection. Cementing supervised by Elmo Hubble, USGS Engineer.

The casing program was as follows:

13-3/8 inch 48#, H-40 surface casing set @ 200 feet and mudded in. 10-3/4 inch 38.7#, H-40 casing set @ 748 feet and mudded in. 7" 20#, J-55 casing set @ 1692 feet and mudded in in anhy. Well was dry and all casing pulled.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
