

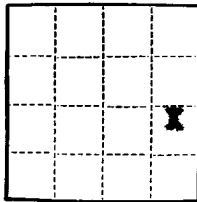

DETAILS OF WORK

We propose to drill at the above location with Cable Tools to an approximate depth of 4000 feet in the Seven Rivers. A string of 13 3/8" casing to be cemented at 200 feet; 10 3/4" casing to be mudded at 750 feet and 8 5/8" casing mudded at 1250 feet. An oil string of 5 1/2 inch casing will be landed at approximately 3950 feet, the 8 5/8, and 10 3/4 inch casing will be pulled and the oil string cemented to surface with approximately 1500 sacks cement.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
