DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded well 5-24-57. Drilled 7 5/8" hole with rotary tools to 327', reamed to 12 1/4" hole to 157'. Cemented 8 5/8" casing at 157' with 150 sacks regular. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 1000/ 30 minutes. No pressure loss. Drilled 7 5/8" hole with rotary tools to 3668'. Cemented 5 1/2" casing at 3667' with 1560 cubic feet 40% Diesel D SR Inocer, followed with 150 sacks neat. Cement circulated. WOC 24 hours. Tested casing with 1000/ 30 minutes. No pressure loss.
