REPORT

The Commission was organized on July 1, 1935, and has since that time been engaged in a study of the oil resources of the State of New Mexico. The Commission has held numerous public hearings and has received many suggestions from the public. It has also conducted extensive research into the oil industry and the conservation of oil resources.

The Commission has found that the oil resources of the State are being rapidly depleted and that it is essential that steps be taken to conserve these resources. The Commission has recommended that the State should take certain steps to conserve the oil resources.

These steps are:

1. To create an oil conservation fund.

2. To create an oil conservation board.
