## 11. OTHER INFORMATION:

- A. <u>Topography</u>: Land surface in the area is relatively level with drainage to the south.

- C. Flora and Fauna: The vegetative cover is sparse and consists of mesquite, weeds and range grasses. Wildlife in the area is that typical of semi-arid desert land and includes coyotes, rabbits, reptiles, rodents, dove and quail.

- E. <u>Residences and Other Structures</u>: The nearest occupied dwelling, a ranch house, is about 0.9 mile south.
- F. <u>Archaeological</u>, <u>Historical</u>, and <u>Cultural Sites</u>: None observed in the area.
