DETAILS OF WORK

Loaded 2-7/8" casing with 12 bbls. mud. Ran Free Point indicator. Out off 2-7/8" casing at 4518' & pulled and recovered 139 jts. Spotted cement plugs as follows: 20 sx from 4418' to 4518', 20 sx from 3550' to 3650', 20 sx from 2000' to 2100', 15 sx from 235' to 335' and 5 sx from surface to 10' With 4" OD Abandon marker cemented extending 4' above ground level. Recovered total of 4509' of 2-7/8" OD casing.

Well plugged and abandoned. Location leveled and cleaned of all material.
