## DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Cemented bottom water, with 6 sacks cement. Filled hole with mud to 3630' and set bridge. Then dumped 10 sacks cement. Filled hole with mud to 2000' and set bridge. Then dumped 10 sacks cement. Filled hole with mud to 1200' and ripped 8 5/8" casing. Recovered 1200' of 8 5/8" casing. Filled hole with mud to 770' and ripped 10 3/4" casing. Recovered 770' of 10 3/4" casing. Filled hole with mud to 610' and set bridge. Then cemented with 10 sacks cement into bottom of 13" casing. Ripped 13" casing at 530' and pulled 530' casing. Filled hole to cellar with mud. Cemented 4" pipe in cellar extending 4' above ground. Filled cellar.
