DETAILS OF WORK

4542' - Total Depth - Dolomite. Ran Schlumberger Survey. Well plugged as follows: Heavy mud from total depth to 3600', 25 sacks cement from 3600' to 3690', heavy mud from 3690' to 2150', 45 sacks cement from 2150' to 1940' - 19' into the 7-5/8" casing, heavy mud from 1940' to surface, 10 sacks of cement in top of 7-5/8" casing at the surface. Set a piece of 4" Line Pipe, cemented in center of 7-5/8" casing, extending 5' above surface of the ground. The 4" Line Pipe marker was filled with cement. Well plugged and abandoned at 5:30 P.M., April 18, 1951.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
