DETAILS OF WORK

(State names of and expected depths to objective sands; show sizes, weights, and lengths of proposed casings; indicate mudding jobs, cementing points, and all other important proposed work)

4342' - Total Depth - Dolomite. Finished drilling 6-3/4" hole at 12 Noon, 4-17-51. No oil or gas zones were encountered. It is our intention to plug and abandon this well, after running Schlumberger Surveys, as follows: Heavy mud from total depth to approximately 3700', 25 sacks cement from approx. 3700' to 3310', heavy mud from 3700' to 2150', 45 sacks cement from approx. 2150' back in to the 7-5/8" casing which is set at 1759', heavy mud to the surface & dump 10 sacks cement in top of 10-3/4" surface casing & set a piece of 4" Line Pipe, cemented in center of surface casing, extending 3' above surface of the ground.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
