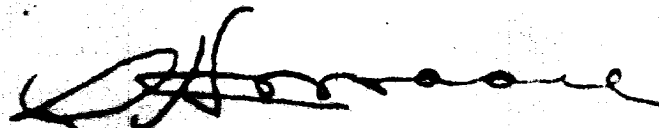
Dear Mr. Hartman:

This will refer to our conversation of last week wherein you called in regard to possible connection of wells to our Eunice and Crane Gasoline Plants. You will recall that it was my opinion that the gas available at Eunice was too far removed to have any possibility of our installing a pipe line to handle your production.

The early part of this month we received a report from our Engineering Division in regard to the prospect of connecting your Sinclair University "P" lease at our Crane Plant, and while this lease is approximately 1-1/2 miles from our system, the payout is over 18.4 years. Inasmuch as you are in a no-flare zone we would like to take another look at the economics and if you would advise us your best judgment of your development rate we will be in a better position to study this situation.
