Gentlemen:

As reflected by our forms C-104 and C-110, our New Mexico State AO 1, Unit "N", located in SE 1/4 of SW 1/4, Sec. 11, T-19-S, R-36-E, was completed June 17, 1956, as an oil well from the Eumont Pool.

We were notified by Mr. A. L. Porter, Jr.'s. form letter, dated July 25, 1956, that in order for us to comply with order R-553, we must either contain a connection for the sale of the casing head gas from our well or secure the exception from the Eumont "no flare" order prior to September 17, 1956.

Warren Petroleum Corporation has signed a contract with Humble Oil & Refining Company to start taking gas from this well by November 1, 1956. However, they did assure us they would be able to connect to take the gas by September 17, 1956.

Due to circumstances beyond our control, Warren Petroleum Corporation has been unable to make a connection to take the gas from this well and have informed us they expect to make a connection and start taking the gas the latter part of September 1956.

In view of these facts, we respectfully request that Humble Oil & Refining Company be granted a forty-five day exception to the "no flare" provisions of the Eumont Pool rules so that we might continue producing from this well.

Your early consideration of this matter will be appreciated.
