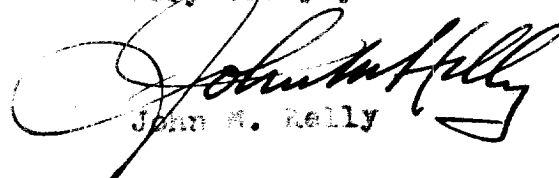
Gentlemen:

John M. Kelly hereby makes application for approval of
a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ of Section
12, T-19-S, R-36-E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support
thereof states the following facts:

- (1) John M. Kelly is the owner and operator of an oil
and gas lease known as the Phillips-State Lease
which comprises the 320 acres above described.
- (2) The Phillips-State No. 1 well located 660 ft. from
the East line and 660 ft. from the South line,
Section 12, T-19-S, R-36-E, was completed February
13, 1953, at a depth of 3843 ft. as a gas well in
the Eumont Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use
this well as the Unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit meets
the requirements of Oil Conservation Commission
Order R-520.
- (4) Attached to this letter of application are letters
from all operators owning interests within 1500 ft.
of the proposed unit well, these letters waive
notice and hearing as to the said applications on
the above described non-standard gas proration unit.
- (5) Attached to this application is a map showing the
structural position of the acreage in the Eumont
Gas Pool.

It will be appreciated if the double allowable to this
unit would be made effective on January 1, 1955.
