FULL DETAILS OF PROPOSED PLAN OF WORK

FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS IN THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE COMMISSION

In order to correct a high gas-oil ratio of this well, it is proposed to ream the hole below the casing shoe at 3780' to T.D. of 4093' and shut off the excessive gas which, as indicated by a recent temperature survey, is being produced from an interval 3780 to approximately 3850'. An effective shut-off will be attempted by use of formation packer or plastic or cement squeeze. After the gas zone is definitely established and shut-off, the section below will be acidized w/ approximately 2000 gals. 15% acid. A report covering results will be submitted subsequent to the above proposed work.
