The undersigned certifies that the above names and regulations of the Oil Conservation Commission have been complied with **except as noted above** and that it is his desire to **authorize** to transport the percentage of oil produced from the above described property and that this authorization will be valid until further notice to the transporter named herein or until cancelled by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico.

This form shall be executed and filed in quadruplicate with the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe, New Mexico, covering each unit from which oil is produced. A separate certificate shall be filed for each transporter authorized to transport oil from a unit. After said certificate has been approved by the Oil Conservation Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter, one copy returned to the producer, and two copies retained by the Oil Conservation Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed to cover each change in operating ownership and each change in the transporter, except that in the case of a temporary change in the transporter involving less than the allowable production for one month the operator shall, in lieu of filing a new certificate, notify the Oil Conservation Commission at Santa Fe, New Mexico, and the transporter authorized by certificate on file with the Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving all from the unit and the name of such temporary transporter and a copy of such notice shall be furnished the transporter previously authorized to transport oil. If the transporter so notified does not receive prompt action, he may temporary transport oil not more than 100 barrels per day until he receives written notice from the Oil Conservation Commission that his certificate has been filed. The Oil Conservation Commission shall issue a permit for pipe line connection and authorization to transport oil from the property named therein and shall remain in full force and effect until 1941.
