Gentlemen:

We are attaching hereto Form C-101 covering the recompletion of an old well and developing gas from a depth of approximately 4500 feet.

This well is located in the center of C NW/NW of Section 13-19S-36E, Lea County, New Mexico and was drilled in 1942 by Skelly Oil Company as their Monstate Well No. 3. Lease was surrendered upon completion as a dry hole.

Stanolind Oil and Gas Company then leased this property along with other acreage and we have secured a farmout from Stanolind subject to certain provisions, including the reopening and testing of this old well.

We propose to redrill to the old total depth of 4500 feet and test for gas and if found in commercial quantities will run and cement 5-1/2" casing as outlined on the attached form.

At this time we do not have the State Lease number, but will secure from Stanolind Oil and Gas Company and forward at an early date.

Shell Oil Company as their Montezuma Well No. 2. Lease was  
announced upon completion as a dry hole.

Stanford Oil and Gas Company then leased this property along  
with other acreage and we have secured a farmout from Stanford  
subject to certain provisions, including the reopening and  
leasing of this old well.

We propose to re-drill to the old total depth of 4500 feet and  
test for gas and if found in commercial quantities will run
