Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas production unit comprising the NW/4 and NE/4 of Section 14, T19S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Lea-State "DA" Lease which comprises the 320 acres above described.
- (2) The Lea-State "DA" #1 is located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line, Section 14, T19S, R36E, Lea County, New Mexico, was completed on August 5, 1954, at a depth of 4,000 feet as a gas well in the Eminent Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas production unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5280 feet.

34, T12N, R10E, S10E, New Mexico County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states
the following facts:

(1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and
gas lease known as the "New-Standard" lease which covers
the 350 acres above described.

(2) The New-Standard Unit is located 1080 feet from the North
line and 600 feet from the East line, Section 34, T12N, R10E, S10E,
New Mexico County, New Mexico, was completed on August 3, 1934, at
a depth of 1,000 feet as a gas well in the New-Standard Gas Pool.
The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.

(3) The proposed non-standard gas property unit will meet the
requirements of Rule 2(f) of the Oil Conservation Commission
Order No. 1-17, as follows:

(a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the
unit.

(b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single quarter-
section.

(c) All acreage within the proposed unit was previously or
previously productive of gas.

(d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not ex-
ceed 350 feet.
