Gentlemen:

Gulf Oil Corporation hereby makes application for approval of a non-standard gas proration unit comprising the NW/4 and NE/4 of Section 14, T19S, R36E, Lee County, New Mexico, and in support thereof states the following facts:

- (1) Gulf Oil Corporation is the owner and operator of an oil and gas lease known as the Lee-State "DA" Lease which comprises the 320 acres above described.
- (2) The Lee-State "DA" #1 is located 1980 feet from the North line and 660 feet from the East line, Section 14, T19S, R36E, Lee County, New Mexico, was completed on August 5, 1954, at a depth of 4,000 feet as a gas well in the Elment Gas Pool. The applicant proposes to use this well as the unit well.
- (3) The proposed non-standard gas proration unit will meet the requirements of Rule 5(b) of the Oil Conservation Commission Order No. R-520 as follows:
 - (a) Contiguous quarter-quarter sections will comprise the unit.
 - (b) The proposed unit lies wholly within a single governmental section.
 - (c) All acreage within the proposed unit may reasonably be presumed productive of gas.
 - (d) The length or width of the proposed unit does not exceed 5200 feet.
