line, Section 23, I-16-S, R-36-E, Las Cruces, New Mexico, was completed on June 6, 1964, at a depth of 3015 feet in the Pecos River Gas pool, about 10 miles from the town limit of Las Cruces. The application for Conservation Order No. R-250, filed by the Conservation Commission's Office of Oil Conservation, proposed to the Commission that the oil production of the Pecos River Gas pool be limited to 1000 barrels per day.

-0- No other permit to pump gas well is contemplated on the 2000-barrel production unit proposed under this application.
