The Texas Company by copy of this letter is hereby requesting waivers from Gulf Oil Corporation and Southern Petroleum Exploration, Inc., who own interest in Section 23, and from Amerada Petroleum Corporation and Continental Oil Company who own interests outside Section 23 but within 1500 feet of the same well.

The Texas Company requests that a non-standard gas proration unit be approved for this well as soon as waivers are received from the above four companies.
