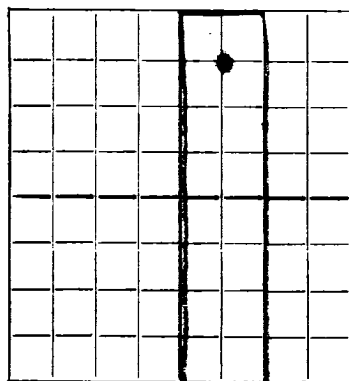

STATE OF CALIFORNIA

Whereas, the State of California is a party to the United Nations Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women, and

And whereas, the State of California is committed to the principles of equality and non-discrimination

in the workplace, and

Therefore, the State of California hereby enacts the following provisions:

Section 1. The Legislature hereby declares that it is the public policy of the State of California to provide for the equal employment opportunities for all persons, regardless of race, sex, or other characteristics.

Section 2. No employer shall discriminate against any person in the workplace on the basis of race, sex, or other characteristics.

Section 3. Any person who violates the provisions of this act shall be liable for damages and costs.

Section 4. This act shall take effect on January 1, 1975.
