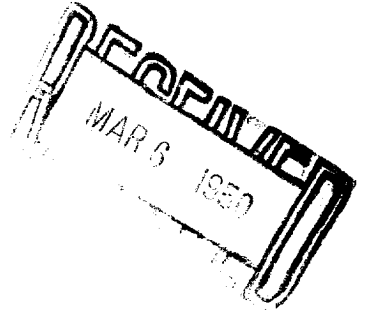

Dear Sir:

The purpose of this letter is to request that our C. H. Weir Well No. 7, located in the SW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 26, Twp. 19-S, Range 36-E, Monument Field, Lea County, New Mexico, be classified as a gas well in an oil reservoir.

This well was completed November 25, 1936, in the Gray-bury formation, from 3877' to 3993', and flowed 489 barrels of oil in 4-3/4 hours. The gas volume was 2,660,000 cu. ft. per day. Since completion the gas volume has increased and oil production decreased to such an extent that the well has been shut in for the last few years.
