Additional information:

This well was drilled to a total depth of 3993'. 2 1/2" upset tubing was set at 3993' and the well swabbed in and would only swabb approximately 1 barrel of fluid per hour. Very little gas. 50% Water.

The well was then acidized with 2000 Gallons of Howell XX acid, Acid went in under Maximum of 1050# on casing and 700# on tubing. The Minimum pressures were 75# on casing and Vacuum on tubing. Acid was followed with 32 barrels of flush oil. The acid set for 6 hours. The well was then swabbed in and flowed 489 barrels of clean oil on a 4-3/4 hour test. Through 2 1/2" open tubing. Hourly average of 103 barrels. Daily gas rate of 2,680,000. Gas oil ratio of 1175.
