12 1/2" 40# 8-End. New Lapweld casing was set in this well at 203' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 800 sacks.

Cement will be drilled out of the casing and the hole will then be bailed dry and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. The bailer will then be run to bottom again to determine if any water has accumulated. If no water had accumulated the drilling will then be resumed.
