Acidized with 1,000 gallons 15% non-emulsifying acid, 3,951-75 feet.

Results: 1st 16 hours flowed 27 bbls. fluid, 30% oil, GOR 27,800:1

next 24 hours flowed 29.7 bbl. fluid, 86% oil, GOR 38,600:1
