**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

Killed well with 250 barrels oil. Lowered 5 1/2" x 40" Exner-Dodge Under-set packer to 3910 with 2 1/2" tubing set at 3970. Let well stand for 5 days when it started flowing. Tested for 5 days averaged 40 barrels per day with GOR ranging from 12,000:1 to 20,000:1, flowing through 10/64" to 18/64" choke. Official test November 13th and 14th showed GOR of 22,400:1, flowing 47 barrels per day through 16/64" choke.
