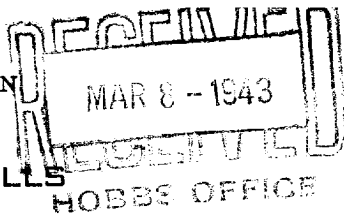

DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Ran 20 sacks of cement in bottom of hole at TD 5,003'. Pumped heavy mud in hole to base of salt at 3,220'. Bridged and dumped 15 sacks cement. Let cement set 14 hours. Pumped heavy mud in hole to 1,830' bridged and dumped 10 sacks of cement. Pumped heavy mud in hole to 114', bridged and dumped 15 sacks of cement in hole, finished filling hole with heavy mud to cellar, dumped 8 sacks cement, erected regulation marker in top of hole.
