DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6-5/8" 20# 10-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 3819' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 100 sacks of cement.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. The cement was then drilled out of the casing and the same test of 1200# pressure again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. The drilling was then resumed.
