(Top of liner @ 3689') As per State Form C-102, dated 4/8/53 - Perforated 6-5/8" OD casing from 2890' to 2912'; 2984' to 2994'; 3430' to 3505'; and from 3520' to 3620'. Treated perforations with 1500 Gallon 15% IST acid - Ran Brown Oil Tool side-door choke set @ 3649'. Well flowed at the rate of 1,041,100 cu ft per day on 20/64" Choke Casing pressure, 600#. Flowing tubing pressure, 475#. Oil is to continue being produced from the Grayburg section from 3924' to 3931'. Gas is to be produced thru casing from the Seven Rivers and Queens section. Well dual completed 4/10/53 -

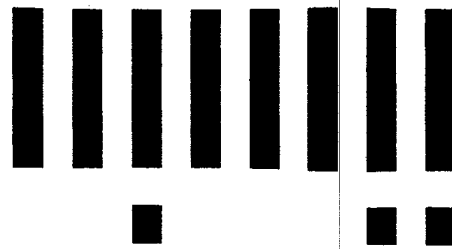

3945' T.D. 3944' PBD. 8-5/8" casing @ 2425'. 6-5/8" casing @ 3815'. 5" Liner set @ 3945'. (Top of Liner @ 3689'). Well originally completed in October, 1937. In August, 1949, well was worked over and 5" liner perforated 3924' to 3931' w/4 shots per ft. (See State Form C-103, Oct., 27, 1949) Oil is being produced from the Grayburg section and is carried currently at 3 bbl per day on the Proration Schedule. It our intention to perforate 6-5/8" casing @ approx 2833'-2843'; 2890'-2912'; 2984' to 2994'; 3430' to 3505' and 3520' to 3620' in the Seven Rivers & Queens Formations to dual complete well. Gas will be produced thru casing from above perforations and oil will be produced thru tbg from the Grayburg section thru 5" liner perf. from 3924' to 3931'.
