DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

3945' Total depth. Before setting packer the well flowed 57 barrels oil on 24 hour test through 11/64" Choke w/ 1,756,000' of gas. W/ gas oil ratio of 30,631.

Killed well w/ water and pulled 2 1/2" tubing. Re-run tubing w/ a Robinson rubber packer. Set packer at 3865' w/ perforations below. Swabbed well in and it flowed 52 barrels oil on 16 hour test. Hourly average of 3-1/4 barrels. Daily gas volume of 272,000'. Gas oil ratio of 3489. Flowing through 24/64" Choke on 2 1/2" tubing. Tubing pressure 140#. Casing pressure 0#.
