DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

6-5/8" 20# New Electric Welded casing was set in this well at 3815' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 100 sacks of cement.

Casing and fitting were tested with 1800# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. No drop in pressure resulted. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied. No drop in pressure resulted so drilling was resumed.
