DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

8-5/8" 20# 8-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 2425' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 300 sacks.

Casing and fittings were tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. Cement plug was then drilled out of casing and the same test again applied. No drop in pressure resulted so drilling was resumed.
