8-5/8" 28# 8-thd. New Seamless casing was set in this well at 2425' and cemented by the Halliburton Method with 500 sacks.

Casing and fitting will be tested with 1200# pump pressure and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes. Cement plug will then be drilled out of casing and the same test again applied and allowed to stand undisturbed for thirty minutes.

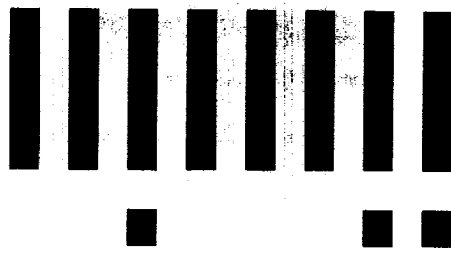
