DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED

Tubing was pulled and rerun with a bottom hole gas arrester bottomed at 3956'. A collar with 1- 3/64" perforation was placed at 2500'. The gas oil ratio prior to this remedial work had increased to 13000-1. The present ratio varies between 1500-1 and 1900-1 with the daily production ranging from 60 to 70 barrels.
