12 1/2" 40# 8-thd. New Welded casing was set at 202' and cemented by the Halliburton method with 150 sacks cement.

Cement plug was drilled out of casing and hole bailed to bottom and allowed to stand undisturbed for one hour. Bailer was again run to bottom and no water had accumulated in hole.
