9953' TD - 5500' PHD - Plan to move in & rig up rotary workover rig, pull tubing, test all perforations with 2000#, squeeze ones that do not test, drill and clean out to 9895', test 5 1/2" OD Casing with 2000#. Run Gamma Ray & Neutron Surveys, perforate for gas production in Simpson Section from 9610' to 9700', 9710' to 9740', 9750' to 9790' & 9800' to 9870'. Acidized above perforations with 500 gallons mud acid and swab if necessary. Recomplete well as a gas-distillate well producing from the Simpson Sand.
