**DETAILED ACCOUNT OF WORK DONE AND RESULTS OBTAINED**

**7532' Drilled Out Depth.** Drilled out cement from 7164' to 7170' which made hole open down to 7532'. Perforated with Lane Wells from 7164' to 7190', 156 holes. Displaced mud with 185 bbls. of oil and set Guiberson Packer at 7164' with bottom of tubing at 7197'. Started swabbing at 4:30AM, 12-4-47, swabbed to tanks from 5:45AM. To 7:00AM, 12-4-47, swabbed 15 bbls. oil. In 24 hours to 7:00AM, 12-5-47, swabbed 82.11 bbls. of fluid, 3% to 10% water.
